

Direct Web-Based Access to the ZANTAZ EAS Archive

ZANTAZ EAS provides extensions for Microsoft Outlook that enable end users to interact with the EAS archive transparently from within the familiar email client after email has been moved into the EAS archive. For organizations that would like to provide end users with direct access to the EAS archive (without the need of an email client), ZANTAZ provides EAS Web Access (EWA). EWA is a web-based application interface to the ZANTAZ archive providing access to Microsoft Exchange messages and files.

Internal and External Data Access

This feature rich platform provides archived data browsing, previewing, searching, and retrieval capabilities in a single web-based interface. With EWA, organizations can access personal archives from any web browser, any time, anywhere in the world.

Easy Access to EAS for Exchange, EAS for Files, and Public Folders

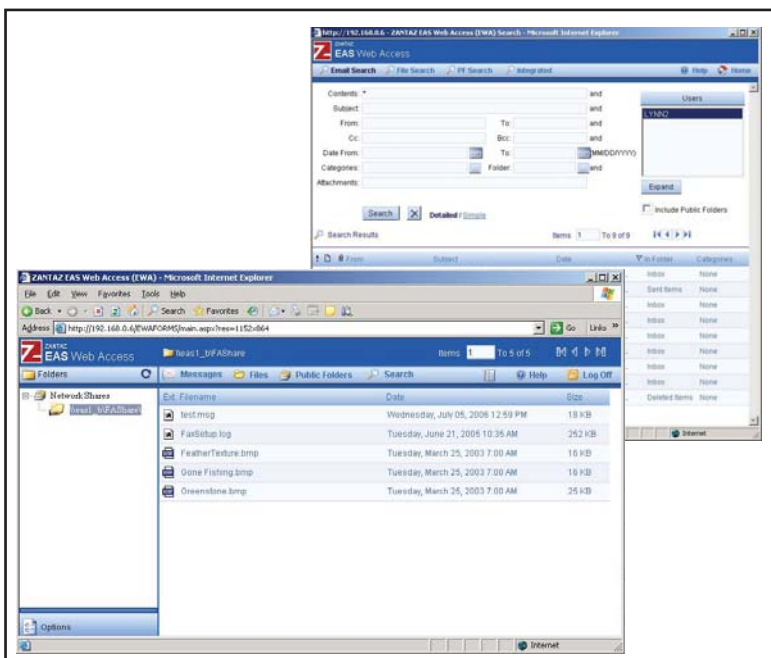
EAS Web Access provides quick and simple access to archived email, files and public folders from a single, secure interface, without the need to log into separate portals. With EWA, users can see all of the archive contents for which they have access rights, regardless of whether or not it is stubbed in their mailbox. EAS Web Access provides a familiar and intuitive user interface, eliminating user training requirements. Due to its unique design, EWA provides access to archived data even when Microsoft Exchange is down. This will result in reduced IT call volume and improved productivity levels.

Customization

The EWA interface can be customized based on personal preference and specific needs including:

- The number of messages displayed in the preview pane
- Color setting preferences
- Show/hide message preview pane
- Time zone selector for all countries worldwide
- Date formatting options (dd/mm/yyyy, mm/dd/yyyy, or yyyy/mm/dd)
- Foreign language support including double byte characters

Once saved on a specific workstation, all preferences are retained for future sessions.



EAS Web Access Interfaces

Quick and easy message, file and attachment retrieval

Archived email and files are accessible through a simple mouse click operation. In addition, email attachments can be quickly reviewed without the need to retrieve the entire email message first through a unique preview interface. EWA provides a Windows Explorer style window featuring all archived file data based on permission levels, including all sub-folders. All archived information is available, whether or not it is stubbed.

Message and file search capabilities

EWA users who also license EAS Search will have access to advanced search capabilities, including the ability to search using a variety of parameters including contents, subject, to, from, cc/bcc, attachment, date range, and folders.

HTML message formatting

All messages are displayed in HTML preview mode.

Field sorting capabilities

EWA provides the ability to sort files by file type, name, date, and size allowing for even faster recovery access.
